Order of Worship



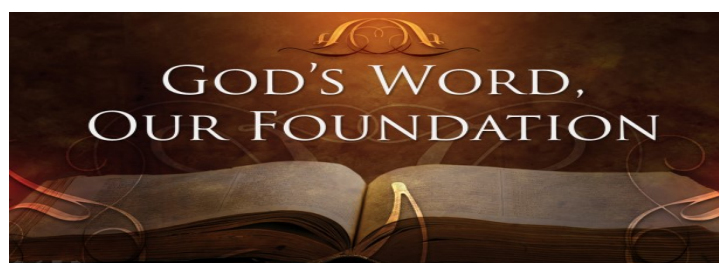
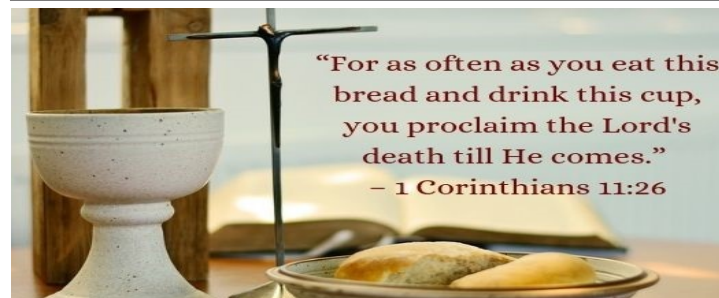

“He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the LORD require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.” Micah 6:8

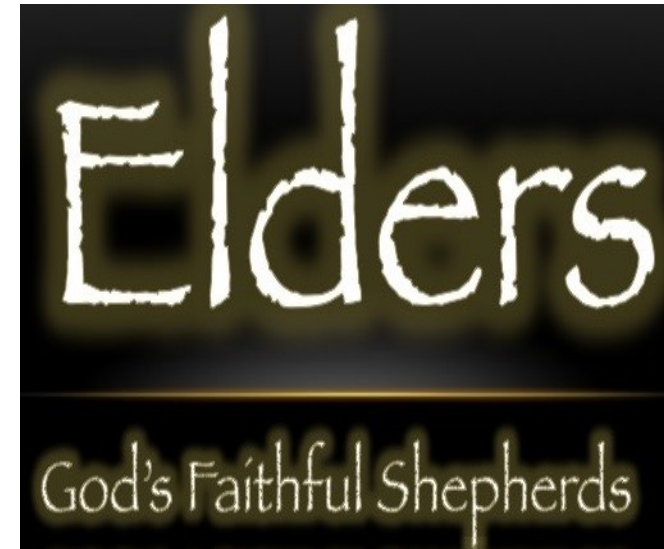

Micah is charged with confronting a smug, self-satisfied Israel. Not only did God's covenant community fail to see how far it had fallen into the ways of sin and selfishness. Israel even felt indignant that God was slow in saving them. Micah's words are simple and eternal. What God required of people in those days of Micah is the same thing that God requires of us today. Today in this sermon, let us focus on these three phrases as they apply to our lives. To do justice, the word *mishpat*, in Hebrew means justice. It means that following God's law means that we treat other people with fairness.

Do justice, what's next? Love kindness. We all know what kindness is, compassion, sympathy, gentleness, sharing, helpfulness. The Hebrew word for kindness, *chesed*, means unconditional love, even for people you don't like; never writing someone off as worthless, going out of your way to help someone even if there's nothing in it for you.

Walk humbly with your God. Walk means slow, measured, a slow deliberate pace. Humbly, is not full of yourself, not preoccupied with what you need or want. Humility is sacrificing yourself and your concerns to listen and respond to the needs of others and the desire of God. Humility is a part of the art of listening, when you forget yourself for a moment and actually listen to what God wants you to know or do. Jesus said that the greatest person in the kingdom of God was a person who was humble like a little child. The followers of Christ were called servants. The key to worshipping God is to sacrifice your own desires, your own busyness of mind, in order to give your attention to God and your fellow human beings. To walk humbly with God is to sacrifice the ego-centered self, your comfort, your pleasure in order to focus on a greater good.

Micah 6:8 will not steer you wrong, the words are so easy to remember, Do justice, love kindness, walk humbly with your God. The truth of them is so profound, write them on your heart and carry them with you daily.

May we earnestly seek to meet these requirements.
