# Order of Worship



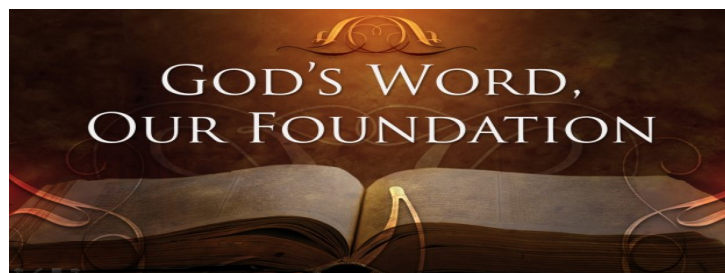
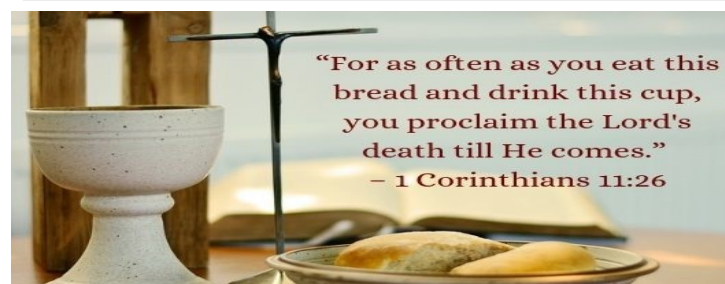

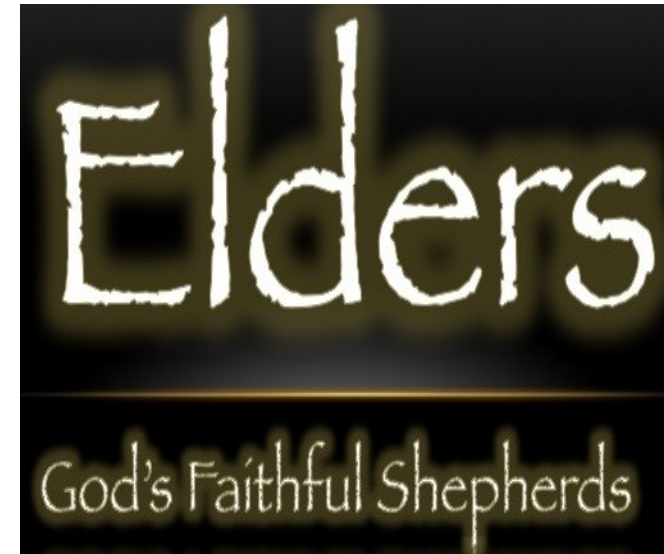

## “The Prayer Quilts”

### Quilts in Hallway:

Please tie all knots twice so they don't come undone.

As you look at Scripture, you find many things which might frighten you. You can read about Jacob's wrestling with God and Abraham's looking up and seeing the smoke rising from Sodom and Gomorrah and David's standing in the shadow of Goliath and Jesus' looking at Peter after the disciple had betrayed the Lord. You find frightening people in Scripture, the serpent, Cain, Jezebel, and Judas. What might be the scariest scene in all of Scripture? I believe we'd find the most frightening scene in all of Scripture at Matthew 7:21-23; you have the scariest event in scripture, standing before the judgment seat of Christ. The Resurrected Christ acting as judge, and He says "I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness." We need to give careful attention to these words of the Resurrected Christ We go through life nonchalantly as though our actions have no consequences.

Some speak empty words; Jesus says not everyone who says to him "Lord, Lord," will enter the kingdom of heaven. Words are cheap currency; we can be just like that with Jesus. We can pray beautiful prayers in the assembly and go home search the Internet for pornography. The obvious implication is that more than simply saying, "Lord, Lord" is required for our salvation. Some people say that all one needs to do for salvation is to confess faith in Jesus. Jesus himself says that's not, we must call on the name of the Lord for salvation (Acts 2:21). We most certainly must confess his name with our lips (Matthew 10:32-33; Romans 10:9-13). Calling on the name of the Lord most certainly involves action. Saul of Tarsus called on the name of the Lord by arising and being baptized in order to have his sins washed away (Acts 22:16). We speak our faith and we demonstrate our faith by our obedience.

Notice how religious these people are, their excuse will be that they have done great things for Christ. The root of the problem, Jesus says, is that they did not obey his heavenly Father. If we do great things for Jesus but refuse to obey him, we will be lost! Jesus will tell these workers of iniquity to depart from him, for he never knew them. Jesus never knew these individuals. Can you think of any more terrifying words than those? Those who hear those words will be damned for an eternity. Those who hear those words will be shut out from God's presence and from the glory of his might throughout eternity.

What if Jesus returns this very day, and when you stand before him in judgment, what will he say to you? Will he say those most blessed words: "Well done, good and faithful servant?" Will you hear the most frightening words in all of time and space: "Depart from me; I never knew you?"

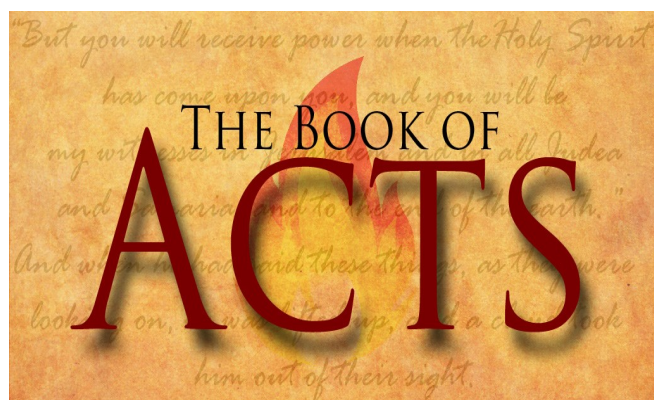
## Announcements
